An excellent example, shown with a sunburst gable, picture frame Georgian glazing and raised, fielded door panels.



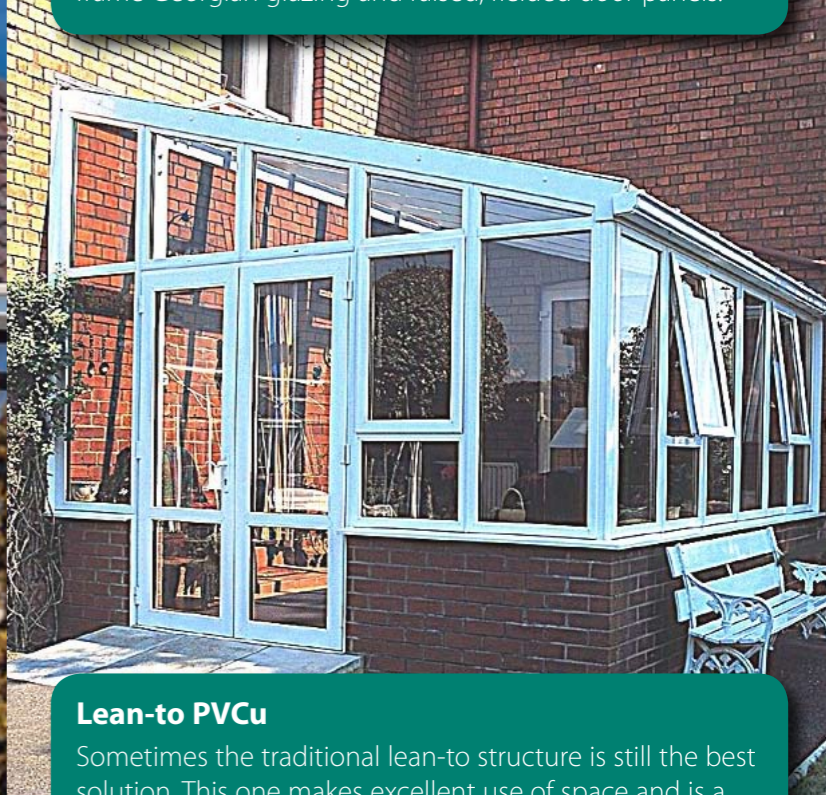
Solar Control Glass & Aluminium

Sometimes the traditional lean-to structure is still the best solution. This one makes excellent use of space and is a stylish addition to this home.



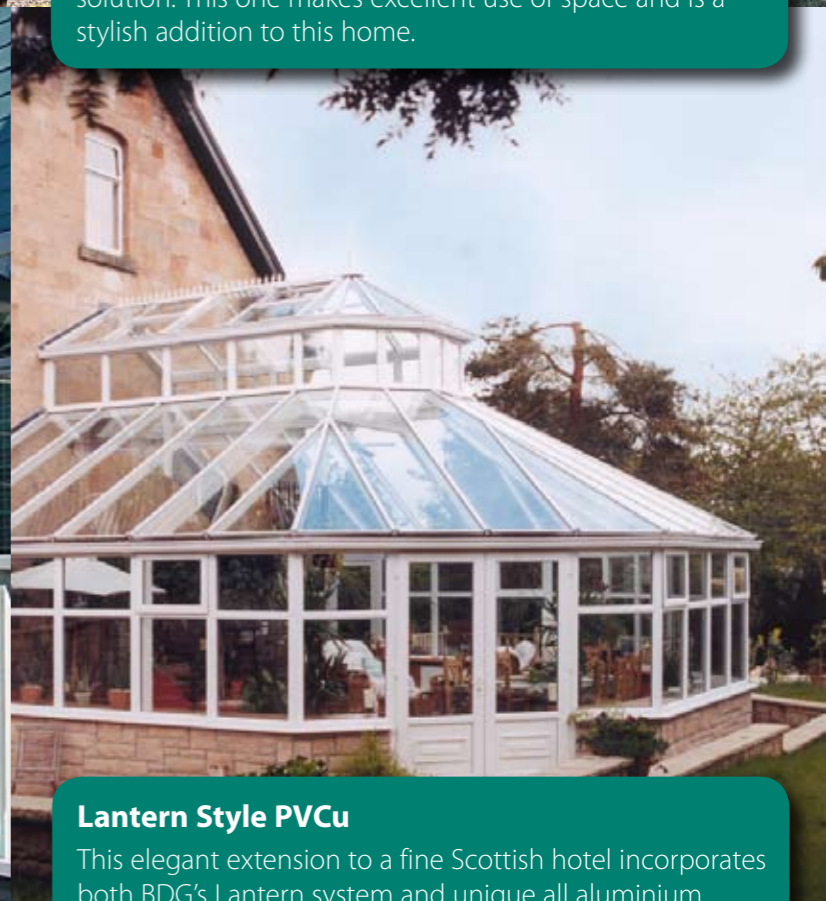
Pavilion Style Free Standing Aluminium Conservatory
